Description	This course has been set up to make all Prep. students better learners; it It exposes them to some fundamentals of studying at a university, and trains them to be better at learning language. The course is based on consciousness raising activities allied with practical exercises.
Objectives	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Acquainting students with the concept of self-directed learning, and to wean them off more schoolish notions of the roles of student and teacher; - Introducing (and checking student understanding of) the academic requirements of the Prep. Program; - Teaching self-management, including: goal setting; time management; and self-care through the maintenance of a balance between study, social life, and health; - Ensuring that students have at least rudimentary study skills, including: techniques for language learning; strategies for working cooperatively; and an awareness of the general exigences of Academic Integrity; - Ensuring that students have adequate IT skills that will facilitate their learning of English, including familiarity with the university's learning management and information systems.

Program's academic requirements (course work, assignments, personal study, and assessments), while remaining health and sociable;</p> <p>LO2. use IT skills necessary for both navigating the AGU Prep. Program and enhancing their learning of English;</p> <p>LO3. apply effective study skills, including: learning new vocabulary; taking, organising, and reviewing notes;</p> <p>LO4. demonstrate understanding of the absolute requirement to complete assignments in an academically honest manner;</p> <p>LO5. continue their studies in a self-directed manner (knowing where to find support as required, and how to access materials for autonomous study).</p>
