Description	This course enables students to attain writing skills in order to be able to write academic essays and reports at the Faculty Level. There is an emphasis on the effective analysis and classification of supplied resources, which students learn to exploit not only explicitly and logically for ease of reading but also appropriately, within the constraints of academic honesty.
Objectives	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Exposing students to a further variety of writing task types ('genres') each with distinct rhetorical structural expectations. - Analysing, in written resources, ideas, opinions, and data that can be used for various rhetorical purposes according to the target writing genre; - Raising learner awareness of how, in a written text, ideas should be ordered logically; - Teaching academic writing conventions, especially those that govern refined attribution of ideas, opinions, and data from supplied source materials; - Teaching students to critically evaluate their own writing, and autonomously improve it.
Learning Outcomes	<p>At the end of Writing 200, learners will be able to:</p> <p>LO1. manage autonomously and in a timely fashion a full writing process cycle, making use of self-review, peer-editing, and instructor feedback to improve a given piece of writing;</p> <p>LO2. construct an answer to a range of task types, with their own distinct rhetorical structural expectations (These will include: Process Description; Cause and Effect, SPRE, and both discursive and argumentative writing);</p> <p>LO3. classify ideas, opinions and data from source texts;</p> <p>LO4. meaningfully exploit ideas, opinions and data from source texts, by integrating them into their own writing in ways that comply with academic writing conventions;</p> <p>LO5. order ideas in a way that both meets generic requirements and aids the reader by being as explicit as possible;</p>
