Description	This course has been set up to enable students to understand the mechanics of English, such that they can use English better in all their other work in both the Prep. and the Faculty English Programs. The focus of the course is both syntactic and lexical. Students will be confident in their ability to manipulate complex grammatical forms in order to report in their own words the utterances/ideas of others. The student will also be able to demonstrate familiarity with around 3000 most commonly used words in English, as identified by the New General Service List.
Objectives	Course Objectives 1. Presenting to students a structural survey of reporting, paraphrasing, and emphasis; 2. Teaching students to use English to report the ideas of others with appropriate emphasis and attribution, and with their own phrasing; 3. Providing students with a strong basis in low-intermediate level English lexis; 4. Providing students with metalinguistic knowledge and skills that will facilitate self-sufficient learning of English for academic purposes.
Learning Outcomes	At the end of Language Awareness 3, learners will be able to: LO1. demonstrate familiarity with the 2800 2730? most commonly used words in English, as identified by the New General Service List; LO2. use awareness of textual cohesion - logical; lexical (EVEN 2?); and grammatical – to understand text more efficiently; LO3. understand various, equivalent, grammatical versions of reported original speech/writing; LO4. analyse complex grammatical forms in order to report in their own words the utterances/ideas of others; LO5. create utterances/ideas of others by means of a range of techniques including in-text citation; LO6. use grammar and vocabulary reference sources such as collocation dictionaries and more advanced grammar reference tables to find better ways to compose more authentic sounding utterances/sentences.

Learning Outcomes	At the end of Reading 3, learners will be able to: LO1. outline useful texts to engage with, without the help of a teacher; LO2. identify patterns of discourse organization such as: SPRE, For & Against, Process, Classification, AMFI (in reports of research); LO3. answer accurately specific questions about a text; LO4. understand texts (≤1500 words) which treat themes such as the environment; health, technology; social issues; LO5. highlight, by completion of analytical grids, textual patterns of discourse organization such as: process description, classification, problem/solution, compare/contrast; LO6. match directly quoted opinions with paraphrased versions of those opinions.

Description	This course is taught in two parts. The first part is Skill- focused part and the second part is Genre- focused part. <i>Summarising</i> consists of some 70 texts, to be collected into a single <i>Summarising</i> Corpus. Studying a good number of the texts, learning the vocabulary related to these academic pieces and writing the summaries of these texts are the main requirements of this course.
Objectives	 Teaching students how to analyse a text according to a range of organisational frameworks - SPRE; Research Report / Survey Report; Argued Opinion; Comparative Evaluation - by identifying key, macro-organisational, elements. Teaching students key phrases that can be used, in their own writing, to explicitly articulate a text's key elements. Teaching students to write an appropriate introductory/topic sentence that effectively prefaces their articulation of a text's key elements. Encouraging students to accelerate and practice their process of comprehension, analysis, and summarising, such that it becomes sufficiently automatic for use in future personal study.
Learning Outcomes	By the end of Summarising a student will be able to: LO1. Identify the key, macro-organisational, elements of a text amenable to analysis as SPRE; Research Report / Survey Report; Argued Opinion; or Comparative Evaluation. LO2. Remember key phrases that can be used to explicitly articulate a text's key elements. LO3. Use, from memory, key phrases in order to explicitly articulate in their own , original, writing, the key elements of another author's text. LO4. Write an appropriate introductory/topic sentence that effectively prefaces their articulation of a text's key elements. LO5. Compose their own topic sentence with descriptions of key elements in order to write, within 30 minutes, a paragraph-length summary of a previously unseen text of 500-1000 words. LO6. Evaluate their own summaries in terms of the course assessment rubric.

Students will study some specialist chemistry vocabulary as well as words which are more generally useful in descriptions of science and technology.

Learning Outcomes	By the end of English for Chemistry a student will be able to: LO1. argue basic ideas and facts with which they are already familiar in their first language, with thus improved range and confidence in English expression overall; LO2. understand a larger discipline-specific vocabulary; LO3. memorize a larger more general vocabulary (understanding that hundreds of words, such as: 'credit, 'reaction', 'portal', 'foundation', which were originally associated with a specific field only are now used much more widely); LO4. attribute potential confusion stemming from the fact that a word such as 'work' has a scientific meaning (physics) that is very different from its everyday, meaning (Force x Distance ≠ Employment); LO5. Analyzing the information in the short, authentic, texts, or the watching of videos, within a particular subject area; LO6. lead a better understanding of faculty study.
